I am writing to you in reference to the Complaint (dated March 31, 2005) filed with the Division of Market Regulation, describing allegations of inappropriate and misleading sovereign credit ratings assigned to the long-term foreign current debt of the People's Republic of China by the Nationally Recognized Statistical Rating Organization ("NRSROs"). I received a copy of this Complaint and based upon the substance of the allegations contained therein, it appears that the reclassification of the sovereign credit ratings of the People's Republic of China is manuated.

Since the NRSROs are regulated by the SEC Division of Market Regulation, I hope that you will agree with me that the very serious nature of the matter which comprises the subject of this Complaint merits your consideration for a formal investigation by the SEC.
